

The "**Excellent Presentation Award**" is intended to encourage and recognize the creativity and excellence of younger engineers/researchers (<35 yrs. old) in the refractories field. Qualification of the candidates and selection of the awardee will be done by a committee that will be convened before the Congress. Based on the self-declaration of potential candidates, at the time of submission of their paper (due May 31, 2011), the committee will qualify some number of candidates by review of their paper (4 pages), including abstract, and their presentation at the Congress. To qualify, the candidates must be listed as the first author on the paper, and actually present the paper at the Congress. The awardee will be introduced and receive a certificate and a small trophy at the banquet closing ceremony on Nov. 2, 2011.
